<u>Current North America Rail Status</u> <u>Customer Advisory No. 2 (Sep 15, 2022)</u>

Dear Valued Customers,

As reported by Class 1 Railroads in North America and various industry news media, a tentative agreement has been reached and is pending ratification. Rail Operations in North America have therefore returned to normal.

Please note Press Releases from Rail Operators below.

Current Rail Statuses:

- **Norfolk Southern (NS):** Announced that tentative agreement has been reached and gates have been reopened. Press Release
- <u>Union Pacific (UP)</u>: Announced that tentative agreement has been reached and the embargo on Hazardous and Security-Sensitive commodities (PIH/TIH) has been lifted. <u>Press Release</u>
- **BNSF**: Announced that tentative agreement has been reached and the railroad will resume normal operations. Press Release
- <u>Canadian National (CN)</u>: Announced that tentative agreement has been reached, rail operations will return to normal, and the embargo on Hazardous and Security/Time-Sensitive shipments (PIH/TIH) has been lifted. <u>Press Release</u>

As ONE had previously advised, 'Change of Destination' (COD) Fees or Detention Charges that were incurred as a direct result of any *actual Suspension of Rail Service/Gates* will be Waived.
