Charleston Port Delays Update #2

Dear Valued Customers,

The Port of Charleston has experienced issues that have affected its ability to work vessels efficiently, as noted in the [June 7th advisory](#). Over the weekend, a Charleston omission was agreed upon for the ONE FALCON 026W. Below is an updated summary of ONE recovery actions for Charleston port delays.

Service	Vessel	Recovery Action
EC5	ONE OWL 026E	Change of Rotation: Call New York before Charleston
EC5	ONE FALCON 026W	Omit Charleston. Imports will be discharged in Savannah for pickup or truck to Charleston. Exports will be rolled to the ONE AQUILA 025W
IE2	APL MINNESOTA 002W	Change of Rotation: Call Savannah before Charleston
EC1	YM WARMTH 037E	Change of Rotation: Call Savannah before Charleston
EC1	ONE MADRID 023E	Change of Rotation: Call Savannah before Charleston
